

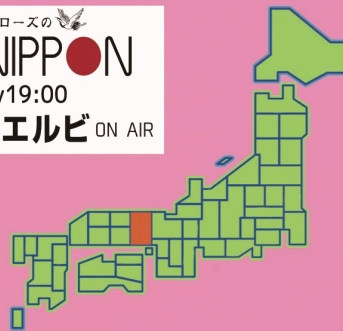

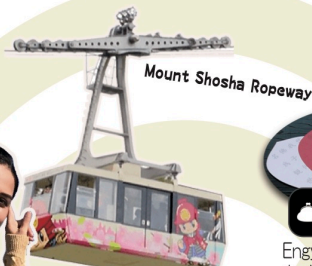

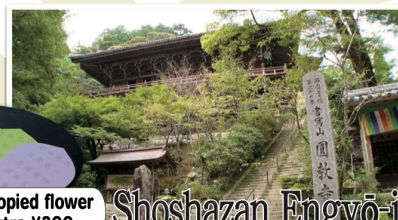

Shoshazan Engyō-ji

Engyō-ji is an old Tendai sect temple also known as the "Mount Hiei of the West." The 27th stop on the 33-temple Saikoku pilgrimage, riding the ropeway will take you into a world of deep mountain valleys. The Mani-den Hall (a large auditorium) resembles Kiyomizu Temple and has been designated an Important Cultural Property. It's also worth taking a look inside the cafeteria!
